VOLUNTEERS

 **693** Total volunteer hours (residents and visitors) worked on 3 previous Anahola homes from 2019-2020.

\$18,850 Value of total volunteer hours worked. In 2020, the value of 1 volunteer hour was \$27.20


SWEAT EQUITY

 **1,268 hours** Average sweat equity worked per family on a group of 3 Anahola homes from 2019-2020 in lieu of a downpayment. The total worked by all families was 3,806 hours.
